This class will give students the opportunity to learn technique, improve skills and perform in ballet, jazz, contemporary and tap styles.

#### **Grades based on:**

- Arriving on time with proper shoes and hair for ballet, jazz and tap
- Staying focused during the class and maintaining proper dance class comportment
- Using full energy, executing movements with attention to detail, implementing corrections and improving

#### **Dress and Hair Code:**

- Students must wear pink canvas ballet shoes with "X" straps already sewn for ballet, black split-sole jazz shoes without laces for jazz and lace-up black tap shoes for tap. Please refrain from wearing jewelry. Girls will not dress out for class due to time restrictions.
- Girls attire for Performance Rehearsals: purchase on your own; pink tights and proper shoes.
- Girls hair should be worn in a bun for ballet and ponytail for all other classes and rehearsals.
- Boys wear black athletic shorts, white form-fitted T-shirt and proper shoes.
- Girls should wear their ballet skirt leotard and tights anytime they are on campus.
- Due to the timing of this class, they will not dress out, just the required shoes.

#### **Studio Etiquette:**

- Show respect for the place we dance and keep it clean. Only water bottles with lids are allowed in the studio. No other food or drink is allowed. No street shoes allowed, only dance shoes.
- Show respect for the teacher by staying silent, focused and working to your fullest potential at all times.
- Show respect for fellow dancers by encouraging them, never criticizing and strive to act Christ-like.

#### **CONSERVATORY FEE:** \$150 per semester – Billed through tuition
