PIANO 1 & 2 (GRADES 6TH - 8TH)

The classes are designed to give students the opportunity to learn to read and play piano literature while incorporating music theory, piano technique & scales, and quality piano literature into their study. Students are individually assessed at the beginning of the term to determine their abilities of whether they will have group or individual lessons. Group is usually used for beginners and individual for the more advanced.

Piano 1 is designed to give the beginning piano students an opportunity to learn to read and play piano literature while incorporating music theory and piano technique into their study. Daily lessons and practice during class time will allow students to advance their skills.

Piano 2 is for those students who wish to advance their piano skills after taking Piano 1. If students have had previous piano lessons, an assessment of their skill level will need approval by instructor.

Grades are based on the following for all piano classes:

- ~Must come to class prepared to **PURSUE EXCELLENCE**
- ~All students must be **ON TIME** and **PREPARED** for every class. This is an extremely pivotal lesson that will be necessary in this class and beyond.
- ~All classroom materials are provided therefore students are expected to take proper care of their piano music and folders.
- ~Weekly grades will be based on **daily participation, music theory quizzes and weekly piano skill assessment.**
- ~All students are **required to perform in a piano recital at the end of each semester as part of their final grade.**
