This class is designed to allow students to explore and experiment with different media while learning the fundamental elements and principles of art. Students will learn in an environment where they will have a hands-on opportunity to test a new medium where they will practice gaining skill and confidence before the process of planning and preparing for project based assignments. Students will begin to understand that our ability to use art to express emotion and creativity is a direct result of our being created in God's image.

Course Objectives:

2. Accurately use the color wheel in mixing colors and discovering color schemes to use while creating artwork.
3. Identify and experiment with Drawing 3D forms
4. Hands on experience with different types media
5. Begin to understand the Principles of Art concepts and how they can use them to develop our skill further
6. Understand the significance of planning and preparing for a project
7. Discuss and explore how our artwork is glorifying and pleasing to the Lord.
